



CAMPING D'AMQUI INC. REGULATIONS

- The registration office is open from 7:30 A.M. To 10:30 P.M. seven days a week.
- Night patrol seven days a week.
- The curfew is at 11:00 P.M. (gate closed). Campers must refrain from making excessive noise between 11:00 P.M. to 8:00 A.M.
- The maximum speed on the campground is 10 km/hr.
- Circulating with quad bikes is only permitted for going back and forth to your campsite.
- Visitors must leave their cars in the parking lot and pay the daily car fees.
- Keep the road ways free in any time.
- Always respect the road signs on the campground.
- Arrange bicycles in the bicycle racks provided on the campground.
- Campfires are allowed and must only be lit at the provided campfire installations.
- Campfires must be attended to and put out before entering into your tents and trailers.
- Fireworks are strictly prohibited on the campground.
- Campers who would like to use the sanitary blocks for group activities or family gathering must ask permission at the reception.
- All campers must keep their campsite clean.
- Trash and recycling material must be thrown away in the designated containers. It is forbidden to throw them away in the campfire.
- It is strictly forbidden to shed gray water on the ground.
- Keep your animals on a leash and pick-up their excrement . Stoop and Scoop! Pets are not allowed in the service buildings.
- Animals are not allowed in the sanitary blocks, the lodging house and outdoor games.
- It is strictly interdict to smoke in the service buildings.
- Campers are asked to respect the natural environment. Cutting or damaging trees is prohibited.
- Clotheslines are allowed and must be installed securely.
- It is not permitted to sublet your campsite, your trailer or any VR vehicles without the autorisation given by the agents at the reception.
- Each trailer must be parked on the gravel driveway and in the correct orientation of the rented site (except in case of second trailer on the same ground). All other requests must first be approved by the Camping authorities.
- Changing campsites must be authorized at the registration office.
- Extension of stay must be notified before 11:00 A.M.
- You must vacate your campsite no later than 11:00 A.M. Arrival time is 2 P.M.
- All campers and visitors must abide by these rules. Anyone violating them may be subject to penalties or expulsion without refund.
- Any behavior judged to be unacceptable by the camp workers , irrespective of the regulations , can lead to an expulsion from the campground.
